# Frequencies and emissions (H-3)

- This is where you will enter the frequencies you are requesting. There are buttons for the frequencies that are allotted to your area and also one that shows what frequencies are still available.
- 28 Will be add
- 29 Is the location number which should match the location number on the schedule D and antenna page.
- 30 The antenna number will usually be 1 but if you are using more than 1 antenna at a site use the antenna number that goes with the frequency.
- 31 This is where you will list your frequency. If you don't know what frequency to use the RPC can assign them for you.
- 32 Station Class, this is going to be FB2, MO FX1 .....
- 33 Number of units. For FB2 it will be 1 for mobiles or 6.1 meter rule you would put how many units will be used.

- 34 If you are using pagers this is where you will list them.
- 35 Output power in watts.
- 36 ERP effective radiated power in watts.
- 37 Emission Designators. You need to provide the emissions your system will use. There is a link you can click on to get a list of valid emission designators but if you do not know what emissions work with your system you should either look at the manual or contact your radio dealer to find out.

# Validation and Selecting a Frequency Coordinator

- Once you have completed your 601 form you will need to validate your application. To do this click the Validate the 601 form link on the lower left hand side of the application.
- If you have filled everything out correctly it will tell you it has been validated. If there are errors on your application it will list them and you will need to correct them before the application can be moved forward. You will have to validate it again after the changes have been made.

# Validation and Selecting a Frequency Coordinator

- When the application has been validated your next step is to choose your Frequency Coordinator. To do this click the link on the lower left hand side for Coordination.
- This will provide you with a list of the 4 Public Safety Coordinators. Choose which one you want the application to go to and click Assign.
- If you have attachments that need to be submitted you can add those by clicking the attachments link.
- Once all of these steps are completed you can now click the status link on the lower left hand side. Click the button for Submit to RPC then click update status.
